Evolve and Grow OUR Community

- ▶ Smart planning /Smart growth:
 - This has been a challenge with little direction set and little progress
- ▶ Improve our tax base while preserving our environment and quality of life:
 - Additional planning required and see “zero tax increase” above
- ▶ Tax incentives vs public investment:
 - Neither theories have been endorsed

Public Safety and Health

- ▶ Reduce and/or enforce speed limits on rural roads:
 - Several changes have been made with more to be addressed
 - To date changes have been made to Highway 620, Jack Lake Rd, Balmer Rd and Jeff/Clydesdale Roads
- ▶ Develop bike/recreation paths and shoulders:
 - Stony Lake Trails have been developed by several private citizens and Kawartha Land Trust on the north shore of Stony Lake in the area of Viamede Resort and Reid’s Road
 - Significant progress has taken place with The Peterborough Active Transportation Plan and Tourism Wayfinding: mapping of bike routes in the Township and planned routes around 620/504 are in process
- ▶ Improve pedestrian safety on Burleigh Street:
 - Significant planning is in progress with the County, OPP, PSB and Council
 - Valuable Community input was received at an Open House on June 22, 2017
- ▶ Community Policing Programs:
 - The OPP have been very supportive of Community policing activities in Apsley
 - The future of NK Community Policing Committee may not continue due to a lack of available volunteers
- ▶ Strategic plan for the Medical Centre with program accessibility:
 - The Medical Centre has three pods
 - Physician\Nurse Practitioner
 - Dentist
 - Additional services such as nutritionist and mental health are also available
 - The Peterborough Family Health Team is currently recruiting for a replacement for Dr. Rayes
- ▶ “Peterborough Hospital First” for critical emergencies:
 - The new program was implemented in 2016 with full support from all interested parties especially Peterborough Paramedics and the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care

Environmental Protection

- ▶ Strategic plan to sustain/improve lake water quality:
 - There is work to be done in this area
 - The topic was discussed at the Open House on August 13, 2017
 - Greater Peterborough Area Climate Change Action Plan and the complimentary North Kawartha Climate Action Plan were endorsed
- ▶ Focus lake re-development bylaws on shoreline preservation:
 - There continues to be significant interest/concern on this topic by many
 - Specific bylaws are to be considered by Council in the near future
 - Further revisions will be considered in concert with the review of the Peterborough County Official Plan
- ▶ Evolve septic re-inspection program for faulty systems:
 - The program is progressing well in the fourth of a five year program
 - Draft requirements for Phase 2 (years 2019-2023) will be considered in the near future by Council
- ▶ Take responsibility for in-water boathouse construction:
 - Council made a determination that new boat houses shall not be permitted on all lakes in NK other than Stony Lake
 - This issue has been appealed to the OMB
