## Summer Job Help from the Feds

Local employers are encouraged to apply for summer help through the Canada Summer Jobs program ASAP. You have until February 2, 2018 to submit your application.

Canada Summer Jobs provides funding to not-for-profit organizations, public-sector employers and **small businesses** with 50 or fewer employees to create summer job opportunities for young people aged 15 to 30 years who are full-time students intending to return to their studies in the next school year.

The government encourages all small businesses and organizations to apply for funding. This program can benefit both employers and students looking to gain experience while earning money for school. Last summer, over \$650K was received in Haliburton-Kawartha Lakes-Brock and dispersed to over 99 different employers for a total of 306 youth jobs.
