In the religious sense, Communion, is the partaking of consecrated bread and wine during a Communion Service - the bread being a symbol of the Body of Jesus and the wine His Blood. It is mostly given by an authorized official of a religious order. In some denominations, the recipient must be Baptized and in others every one may partake. In the Catholic Church, communion, which is a part of the Mass, may only be given

to its members. In the last few years, many churches have substituted grape juice for the wine to include those individuals who cannot consume alcohol. The method of administering the wine has changed after recent outbreaks of various illnesses which could be passed from one person to the next. Instead of a common chalice, the wine is served in small individual glasses. At Trinity, this is the method that is used and communion is served to all who wish to participate.
