EIGHT-YEAR HIGH IN BOATING FATALITIES

In May, the OPP reported that boating fatalities on OPP-patrolled waterways reached an eight-year high in 2017, with 31 people dying last year compared to 23 deaths in 2016.

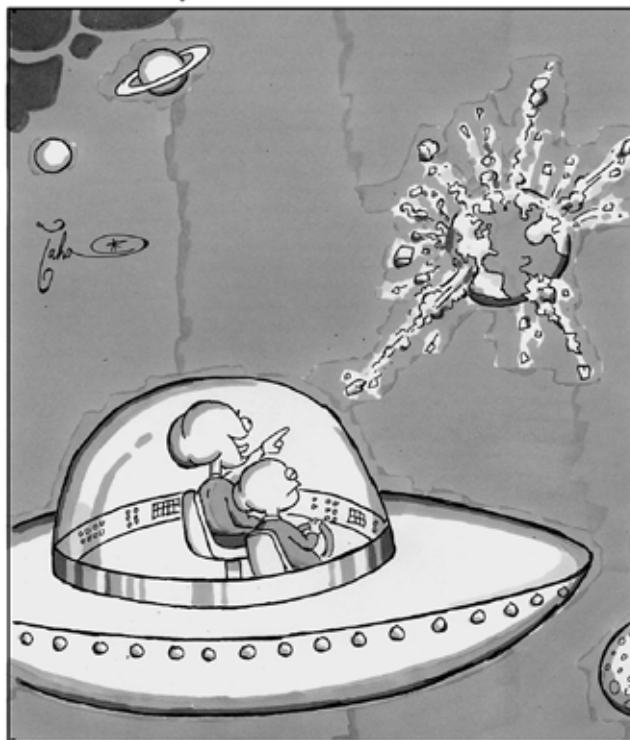
“**Falling Overboard**” was the lead contributing factor in both years, as the outcome could have been different for the 42 victims who were found **not (properly) wearing a personal floatation device**.

Boat operator and passengers are encouraged to consider the following suggestions when heading out on the water in any type of watercraft:

- Wear a personal floatation device or lifejacket
- Don't operate any watercraft while impaired
- Obtain relevant licencing
- Ensure you have all the required safety equipment
- Ensure your watercraft is water ready
- Be wary of the dangers of cold water immersion (especially this time of year)
