We know that Internet service is a real challenge for many people. We are working with all levels of government to ensure this area receives (more than) our share of the recently announced \$142 Million for local internet access. Previous funding provided fibre-optic cable and towers on Hwy 28, and major County Roads, so it is a matter of installing the best "off-ramps" to the existing "highway".

We are dealing with low population density, seasonal population surges, and tough geography – all reasons why this investment is so necessary. Our seasonal residents come from large population centres, where high-speed internet is affordable, and they fully expect the same thing here. Our local economy has many entrepreneurial businesses, which require 'cloud' connections and on-line customer and supplier connections, and we need support for VPN access to corporate systems.
