... at the Art Gallery of Bancroft by Molly Moldovan

September at the AGB features **Inheritance**, Apsley artist **Kimberly Tucker's** intriguing exhibition of *sculptural assemblage*. About this body of work, Kim states:

*"My current work is an ongoing investigation of wool, a renewable resource juxtaposed with the permanence of man-made materials. By combining elements such as felted wool, porcelain and discarded objects, I create assemblages to explore the excesses of consumerism, accumulation of waste and the role cultural debris plays as an inherent part of the environment. My sculptures present an alternate reality of observations made while hiking in woodlands where I encounter discarded objects with a permanent presence in the environment."*

**Inheritance** can be viewed from September 4 to 28, with the opening reception on Friday, September 6 at 7:30pm.

Also happening at the AGB in September: On Sunday, September 29, 9am to 4pm, *Our Lovely Loons*, a workshop in watercolour painting with instructor **Debra Bannister**. In this one-day workshop, artists will engage in the use of specific design, colour, value, and edge techniques to create their own lovely loon painting. Reference materials and handouts will be provided. This workshop is intended for beginner to intermediate artists.

Artists are expected to bring their own supplies and a

supplies list will be available to registered participants before the workshop.
